**STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE
PHMSA DOT Post-Accident Testing Checklist**

This checklist must be completed BEFORE ordering a DOT PHMSA post-accident drug or alcohol test. If any requirement below is not met, the test should typically be ordered as a NON-DOT post-accident test.

1. Did the incident involve a PHMSA-regulated pipeline?

- ☐ Gas pipeline
- ☐ Hazardous liquid pipeline
- ☐ LNG facility
- ☐ Yes
- ☐ No → If NO, order NON-DOT post-accident testing.

2. Was the employee performing a PHMSA 'covered function'?

- ☐ Pipeline construction
- ☐ Pipeline maintenance
- ☐ Pipeline operations
- ☐ Emergency response

- ☐ Inspection work on a pipeline facility
- ☐ Yes
- ☐ No → If NO, order NON-DOT post-accident testing.

3. Is the accident or incident reportable under PHMSA regulations?

- ☐ Gas pipeline incident (49 CFR Part 191)
- ☐ Hazardous liquid pipeline accident (49 CFR Part 195)
- ☐ Yes
- ☐ No → If NO, typically NON-DOT.

4. Could the employee's actions have contributed to the incident?

- ☐ Yes → ORDER DOT PHMSA POST-ACCIDENT TEST
- ☐ No → DOT test not required

Required Testing Time Limits

Alcohol Test: within 2 hours (no later than 8 hours).

Drug Test: as soon as possible but no later than 32 hours.

Quick Decision Rule

Did the incident occur on a regulated gas or hazardous liquid pipeline?

YES → DOT PHMSA Post-Accident Test

NO → NON-DOT Post-Accident Test
